INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Russian as a Foreign Language

Intensive Russian language classes are designed to improve participants' proficiency in grammar, vocabulary, and conversational skills. Through interactive lessons and practical exercises, participants will develop the ability to communicate effectively in various contexts.

Design Thinking Workshop

This hands-on workshop introduces participants to the principles of design thinking. Focused on creative problem-solving, participants will learn to approach challenges with innovative solutions, enhancing their critical thinking and adaptability.

Negotiation Skills Workshop

Participants will gain essential negotiation techniques and strategies to achieve mutually beneficial outcomes in professional and personal settings. Interactive exercises and case studies will help refine these skills in real-world scenarios.

Cross-Cultural Communication

This session explores the nuances of cross-cultural interaction, equipping participants with the tools to navigate cultural differences effectively. Emphasis is placed on fostering mutual understanding and improving interpersonal communication.

Russian Economy and the Influence of Eurasian Integration Processes on Its Development

An in-depth lecture analyzing the dynamics of the Russian economy and its role in regional integration initiatives such as BRICS and the Eurasian Economic Union. Participants will gain insights into how global and regional trends shape economic policies.

Sightseeing Tour of Moscow

Participants will explore historical and modern sites, deepening their understanding of Russia's rich heritage and vibrant culture.

Closing Session and Certificate Awarding

The program concludes with a final reflection session, where participants share key takeaways and celebrate their achievements.

Negotiations are a highly sophisticated type of business communication. To negotiate successfully, we should know different strategies and tactics, gain cross-cultural competence and realize how the language we use can help us achieve our goals and build a mutually beneficial relationship with our partner.
